Claim Credit for Codequest FAQs

1. How do I claim credit for attending Codequest 2018?

Claim credit online by typing bit.ly/2018Codequest into your browser. Follow the instructions on the webpage.

Physicians: Select "CLAIM CME (PHYSICIANS)"

Non-physicians: Select "CLAIM CEU/CERTIFICATE"

2. When can I claim my course credit?

Claim credits within 30 days of the course date.

3. What other course credits can be obtained other than CME?

IJCAHPO CE Credits: Ophthalmic Allied Health Professionals receive 4 IJCAHPO "A" CE Credits for completion of this course.

NBCOE CE Credits: The American Academy of Ophthalmology Codequest™ Coding Course has been approved for 4 Certified Ophthalmic Executive (COE) credits by the National Board for the Certification of Ophthalmic Executives (NBCOE). The COE credential is the property of the American Society of Ophthalmic Administrators (ASOA) and is administered by the NBCOE.

AAPC will grant CE credits to courses that have CME approval.

4. How do I claim AAPC credit?

Sign in on the AAPC website. Under "My Account" click on the tracker. Click on the orange "Add CEUs" button. On the "CEU Information" page answer "No" to the question "Do you have the index/catalog number?" Type in the requested information and save.

5. Will you send me a copy of my course credits?

For Members: The Academy does not mail CME certificates. As a service to members only, the Academy maintains a cumulative record of all Academy-sponsored *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*™ earned by its members for a ten-year period. An official CME Transcript is available on the Academy's website.

For Non-members: The Academy does not provide CME/CEU transcripts for non-members but, upon request, will provide verification of credits earned for a single Academy-sponsored CME activity. However, it is the responsibility of non-members to verify with their own reporting agencies (professional associations, hospitals, state licensing boards, etc.) whether Academy credits are acceptable.

6. What is the Academy's accreditation for Codequest?

The American Academy of Ophthalmology is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The American Academy of Ophthalmology designates this live activity for a maximum of 4 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*™. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.
